

Front of Fair Subcommittee October 29, 2017, mtg report/notes

Light attendance probably due to not getting the word out from the last full committee meeting. Next time send a reminder just before the meeting. Approved the agenda with the adjustment of focusing on getting organized and prepared for next subcommittee meeting with more of us in attendance.

Reviewed Stakeholders list: Add Bikes (Lot crew/external security) Whitebird, Fire, Big Boys, BUMS

Functions: Will call window, parking, Security Bag Check, Ped Walkway, Medallion Row, 4-A Parking, Refer, ice sales, (add bathroom for public at snooze pass?) Bus loading/unloading, Recycling, Emergency parking, Operational parking, Sheriff parking, Ambulance entrance, Joyful entrance, (curb appeal), Junkyard dop, admissions, water barrels and rest stops, crew services gator, Quartermaster/main camp functions, maincamp fence, Recycling...a truck farm visible for customers/infrastructure, Bus on/off site, Ped traffic, neighboring campgrounds, Little Wing/whitebird station, registration sticker booth, Dragon: 4 A, Dog Control, rest area, Horse traffic, Cedar (mediation service), solar charging, music sometimes., ATM, Little Dragon info booth, Bag Check (water dragon), Check-it Booth, Security Bag Check, Staff Entrance at Wind gate, Solar array (has to be 100 feet from Indian Creek, FARTS (pre/post), Cart Central, Pedicabs, Reefer (emergencies delivery function), Showers, Bucks, Firetruck, Security zone, Entrance to Main Camp (Art project Wall?), Pay phones, bus turn around, (Need to Define boundaries/define scope, most of focus starts with Line in the Sand but also include improvements, from Maple Gate in),
