

GREEN ZONE Proposal and Recommendation Form

A "Green Zone" is a designated area of land in which human impacts are to be avoided. This form is used to propose boundaries of a green zone that may be established, recorded, and protected. The Site and Facilities Manager will verify the green zone and see that it is recorded and mapped. Green zone designation may be recommended by booth reps, crew coordinators, camp hosts, campers, Vegmanecs, biologists, or others.

For active bird nests or other wildlife, notify the Quartermaster's Wildlife Team for rapid response. Bird nests need to be addressed quickly. Sites consistently used by nesting birds or critical habitat for other wildlife may be candidates for green zone designation. Protocol: Stewards install signs and flagging weeks before Fair and remove them after. Stewards record the date the zone is flagged and the date flags are removed, inform and educate neighbors and others, monitor compliance and refer disputes to the camping crew, Vegmanecs, BUMS or Site and Facilities Manager.
